Subject:	Waiver of IRP and IFTA Requirements Due to Hurricane Florence
Date:	September 12, 2018

State of emergency declarations are being issued by jurisdictions along the east coast in anticipation of Hurricane Florence. The Arkansas Department of Finance and Administration understands that it will be necessary to expedite relief efforts because of the damage expected from the hurricane.

The Arkansas Department of Finance and Administration is granting a temporary waiver of requirements associated with the International Registration Plan (IRP) and International Fuel Tax Agreement (IFTA) for any motor vehicle traveling through Arkansas that is engaged in disaster relief efforts. This waiver does not allow any vehicle to operate in the state without valid registration and insurance as required. Carriers must maintain all normal requirements that fall outside of IRP and IFTA.

This waiver is effective immediately (September 12, 2018) through 11:59 p.m. on October 31, 2018.
