Dear Member Jurisdictions,

IFTA, Inc., continues to stay abreast through various news articles about proposed legislation that may provide a "tax holiday" or pause on the collection of the motor fuel taxes by various jurisdictions.

Depending on what your jurisdiction may be proposing, this could affect the IFTA tax returns. We post the tax rates for all jurisdictions on our website and have established deadlines in which jurisdictions are required to upload their tax rates for that quarter. Jurisdictions rely on this information by a certain date to have time to program all tax rates into their IFTA return system.

Over the course of the last couple of weeks, I have had conversations with a few jurisdictions that have contacted me before implementing any "tax holiday" to talk about the effect on IFTA, Inc. and the best way to proceed so that IFTA, Inc. and all our member jurisdictions have time to program any changes to tax rates into the system. However, there appears to be other jurisdictions that have or are getting ready to implement changes to the tax rates that may or may not be possible given the time constraints and other restrictions in programming multiple tax rates.

IFTA, Inc. encourages all jurisdictions who are contemplating a tax holiday or pause in the collection of motor fuel taxes for a certain period of time to reach out to me before implementing any changes so that we can ensure that the proposed changes can be implemented accurately, timely and efficiently.
