Wildfires in Texas, Kansas, and Oklahoma have created an emergency need for animal feed delivery. Indiana, through the Department of Revenue, has granted a temporary emergency travel exemption to suspend International Registration Plan (IRP) and International Fuel Tax Agreement (IFTA) enforcement for vehicles traveling through Indiana from March 21st through April 8th to provide immediate aid, emergency response, recovery and support in Texas, Kansas and Oklahoma.

The IFTA and IRP regulation *emergency exemption* is effective Tuesday, March 21, 2017 and will continue through Saturday, April 8, 2017. Enforcement action will recommence April 9, 2017.
