RE: Missouri IFTA Transmittals

Dear Mr. Martorana:

The Missouri Department of Transportation implemented a new IFTA credentialing system in February 2022. As a result of learning new transmittal processes, a human error occurred during multiple transmittal files. The monthly transmittals files sent in May and June, contained duplicated and some triplicated transactions. Missouri attempted to fix the May duplicated file in August. Unfortunately, the attempted fix created an additional transaction instead of a reversal transaction. This was corrected in September.

Missouri is working with our system vendor and with IFTA, Inc. to correct the duplications. Two reversal files are required to fix all data. The first reversal file was sent in October. The second, and final, reversal file will be sent in November.

The reversal files will net funds for the transactions that were transmitted more than once.
